## **COVID-19 RESPONSE: UPDATE #7**

LNG Canada and JGC Fluor (JFJV) continue to implement important measures to help reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus. ### **UPDATED COVID-19 MEASURES TAKEN**

- The project is implementing additional measures to minimize dirt and dust in its facilities to reduce the need for sweeping, which can distribute virus droplets into the air.
- These mitigation measures align with guidance from the Public Health Agency of Canada, as outlined in [Coronavirus Disease \(COVID-19\) Cleaning and Disinfecting Public Spaces](#), and include:
  - Application of a compound to facilities' floors that reduces airborne dust and eases the removal of dust and dirt.
  - Where feasible, occupants will remove boots at the entrances to all buildings and use indoor footwear or use disposable boot/shoe covers.
  - Sweeping will no longer occur and wet mops will be used to clean floors.

LNG Canada and JGC Fluor value the continued hard work, resilience and dedication of our team. As a token of our gratitude, over the Easter long weekend, we held appreciation lunches at site. The lunches were provided by a local food truck and occurred over two days to accommodate our strict physical distancing and sanitization measures. In addition, everyone received a chocolate Easter bunny and a Thank You card.

It has been one month since we stood up the LNG Canada/JFJV unified command incident management team and put into action our response to COVID-19. During this time we have implemented significant mitigation measures. We continue to monitor the situation and adjust our plans and actions as required. Our approach remains aligned with the Government of Canada and Government of B.C. notices for construction sites.
