Cedar Valley Lodge

JGC Fluor BC LNG JV (JFJV) is committed to ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of the people working on the LNG Canada Project. As part of that commitment, we are building Cedar Valley Lodge, a premium workforce accommodation centre.

Providing high-quality accommodation is a key component of the project's labour approach to attract and retain workers, as well as reduce strain on local facilities and services. The lodge is being built on the LNG Canada Project site and, once complete, will have capacity to house approximately 4,500 people.



We want Cedar Valley Lodge to feel like a home away from home; a place where everyone feels safe, is served nutritious meals, has access to a variety of entertainment and leisure activities, and at the end of the day is able to keep in touch with friends and family.

Amenities

The lodge will feature single occupancy bedrooms with ensuite bathrooms, cable television, and wi-fi. A luggage valet service will also be available, so people can leave items they may need on their next rotation.

Residents will have access to a dining facility, retail area, games room, lounge, and a movie theatre. Recreation opportunities include a gym with a track and fitness equipment, an outdoor field for sports, a golf simulator, as well as racquetball and squash courts.

On-site Medical Services

The project site also has its own health clinic, which provides workers with access to primary, preventative, and mental health care, along with work-related injury evaluation and treatment.

Code of Conduct

Measures are in place to ensure safety for workers and the community through the project Code of Conduct, which outlines expectations for every individual assigned to the LNG Canada Project – all employees of JFJV, our subcontractors, and sub-subcontractors – without exception.

The Code of Conduct states that workers will be safe, will contribute to project quality, and will demonstrate behaviours and attitudes that positively impact the community.
