COVID-19 POSITIVE CASES: UPDATE #1

Northern Health Authority has confirmed additional positive COVID-19 cases at the LNG Canada Project site in Kitimat, B.C. All affected individuals have been placed in isolation and are being cared for in their homes or at the project's on-site facilities by medical and support staff. Contact management and tracing have gone well, and will continue. We send our good thoughts to all those who have tested positive and wish them a swift recovery.

All cases have occurred in the same general work location. There are no public exposures in Kitimat resulting from the event at this time.

COVID-19-related data and information are within the Northern Health jurisdiction, and information relating to cases and individuals are subject to strict privacy laws. Questions with respect to such information should be directed to Northern Health.

- We are actively reviewing our COVID-19 safety plans with Northern Health and will make all necessary updates as they are identified.
