To be considered for potential work on the LNG Canada Project as a Subcontractor, Supplier, or Sub-subcontractor, JFJV needs to know about your company. Please complete this questionnaire as completely as possible (using additional pages if required for your answers). This will allow JFJV to add your company and your company's services / supplies to JFJV's "Registry of Interested Companies" database.

Please note that JFJV's registry is NOT a list of pre-qualified companies; it's merely a contact registry that JFJV and JFJV's Subcontractors may access for specific scopes of services or supply needs. If your company is selected to potentially bid on a Subcontract or a Purchase Order directly with JFJV, JFJV will contact you requesting a Non-Disclosure Agreement and will provide you with a full pre-qualification package to complete and return. Similarly, if your company is selected to potentially bid on a Sub-subcontract or a Purchase Order directly with one of JFJV's Subcontractors, you may be contacted by that JFJV Subcontractor requesting a Non-Disclosure Agreement and pre-qualification information.

Please note that being a registered company in JFJV's database does not guarantee that your company will be asked for additional information or that your company will receive a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a Subcontract with JFJV, a Sub-subcontract with a JFJV Subcontractor, or a Request for Quotation (RFQ) for a Purchase Order with JFJV or a JFJV Subcontractor. However, JFJV and JFJV's Subcontractors are obligated to seek out and provide opportunities where appropriate and practical; giving preference to local and aboriginal businesses.

JFJV may follow-up with you to request additional, detailed information about your local office or operations center in Kitimat or Terrace to document / confirm your Local Business status.</i></p>

<p><i>“Aboriginal Business” is defined as a business enterprise that is legally registered in one of the Provinces or Territories in Canada where the work is to be performed and is: (i) a band as defined by the Indian Act, including without limitation Métis, Inuit or Indians; (ii) a sole proprietorship; (iii) a limited company; (iv) a co-operative; (v) a partnership; (vi) a not-for-profit organization; or a (vii) joint venture consisting of one or more (Aboriginal) enterprises; and the foregoing has at least fifty point one percent (50.1%) ownership by Aboriginal peoples for which the management and daily business operations are controlled and operated by one or more such individuals.</i></p> <p><i>If no response is provided, we will assume you are not an Aboriginal Business. JFJV may follow-up with you to request additional, detailed information such as an executed Joint Venture agreement to document / confirm your Aboriginal Business status.</i></p>
