## Sisterhood in the Brotherhood

A women's group meets weekly on the LNG Canada Project site bringing females together for an open dialogue to connect. It is important to have a safe space to come together, talk and to build relationships. This group meets weekly at Cedar Valley Lodge for approximately an hour.

During this time, conversation flows naturally, and participants discover commonalities and shared interests. It's a safe space to check in and be there for one another as we empower, grow, and support the sisterhood.
